What funds are available?

- Student loans will help with
 - Tuition Fees (max £3290 for 2010-11)
 - Living expenses (max £4950 - £6298)
- Bursaries
 - University grants – not repaid
 - Vary from place to place
- Support varies according to parental income
- Scholarships
 - Not repaid – amounts vary
 - Often linked to grades and subjects
